




Pine Tree Stars Quilt - Supply List

The Lap Quilt (58 x 67 inches) is shown on the front cover



BACKGROUND FABRIC				
It is HIGHLY recommended that the background fabric is a solid or lightly printed fabric and that the tree background, the sashing and border fabric are the same.

Items you will need for the quilting -

Thread - Use whatever thread works in your quilting machine and we will be using a few different threads for this project. Here are some suggestions for thread.

Background Fabric Quilting - we want this quilting to "disappear" and not be noticeable. I highly recommend a thread that matches the background fabric.

Tree Quilting - green or variegated green thread for the tree quilting. If you don't have a variegated thread, use a green thread that matches most of your tree fabrics.

Trunk Quilting - brown or brown variegated thread

Star Quilting - yellow solid or a gold thread. You could use a metallic thread, but you may have problems with thread breakage. I recommend a high sheen poly thread in a "gold metallic" color.

Thread Embellishing - we will be using most of the colors or threads above but will be adding more basic colors. This will be discussed in the class.

When we do the "**thread embellishments**" on this quilt, we will be using markers to make "guide lines" and we will be color coding the guide lines.

I prefer the **Fine Point Crayola Washable Markers**. I recommend getting a new set of these markers.

Note - to remove the marker, the quilt **MUST** be washed in warm water, with detergent, in a washing machine.
